Temporary Gas Heat Inspection

This inspection is necessary when Temporary Heating supply and appliances have been installed, before being put into operation.

Check

The following are the most common items audited during this inspection. However, the list is not exhaustive. The work must meet all the applicable codes and standards.

Piping has been installed and meets the CSA B149.1 Natural Gas and Propane Installation Code and the
CSA B149.2 Propane Storage and Handling Code
Regulators have the proper clearances to windows and are not located inside the building.
Heaters have the proper clearances to combustibles
Temp furnaces, if applicable, have:
Plenum shields
Furnace filter installed
Proper venting through a window
